Victoria Australia to Oshkosh Wisconsin

Mark Dewey is a Senior Constable (Badge# 24545) with the Victoria Police Department in Australia. During his visit to the EAA last year I got to know the Constable and arranged a tour of OPD as well as a ride-along when he returned for AirVenture this year.

Our tour and ride-along was scheduled for Saturday August 2nd. Mark and I arrived at OPD 15 minutes before Sgt. Harris arrived. During this time I showed Mark the OPD fleet of Squads, marked, unmarked, and CSO trucks. He got a big kick out of the Parking Authority car because the position of the steering wheel was not out of place for him. The cage partitions separating the back seats of the squads were also of interest, in Australia they do not put people in the back of squad cars they have to wait for a police van to come and take them to jail.

When Sgt. Harris arrived, we began our tour of OPD. Among other things I showed Mark our new OAP radio room, and gave him a quick rundown of our radio procedures. At the conclusion of the tour Mark gave Sgt. Harris a Coffee mug from them Victoria Police Department. Sgt. Harris gave Mark an Auxiliary Coffee mug, an SFST booklet and some department stickers.

We left the department and Sgt. Harris drove past the Farmers Market and explained to Mark all the different events we have in the city. He then drove to the Wittman Airport terminal, were the Thunderbird F-16's were parked. We briefly looked at the jets lined up and got our picture taken with them. We then headed to the Main Street Best Western Hotel to begin the escort of the Thunder Birds pilots and crew. Mark and I both got our pictures taken with the pilots. Mark road with Sgt. Harris as the lead of the escort, I worked traffic light assignment and afterward met back up with them at the airport. Sgt. Harris took us to the new OPD commanded vehicle and gave mark a tour of it. We finished our day when we drove to the EAA Grounds. Sgt. Harris had to go to attend a safety meeting so I gave Mark a ride back to the department to end the day.

Mark made me an "Honorary" Victoria Police Officer. My title is Alex Williams Lead Senior Constable of International relations, Badge# 00055 (He's trying to get me a actual badge from his department)

Mark mentioned that if anyone from OPD...Officer, Auxiliary, or CSO comes to Australia they need to let me know and he will roll out the red carpet just as OPD did for him. He felt very welcome to our city and very safe. He is very impressed by the amount of professionalism and dedication our Auxiliary unit has, and is amazed that we do it all unpaid and un-armed. What we do is unheard of in Australia.
