

SPEED WATCH TRAINING



The Oshkosh Police Department will be holding a Speed Watch Training Session on Tuesday, October 25, 2011 at 6 pm in the Erickson Room of the Oshkosh Police Department.

Speed Watch training will consist of about one hour of classroom instruction and one hour of hands on instruction. To become a Speed Watch member, you will need to pass a background investigation and complete the training. The age requirement has been changed and is now open to 15 year olds who are attending high school and shall be accompanied by an adult parent or guardian to the training and while a Speed Watch member.

Speed Watch is a volunteer program where volunteers operate the radar at various locations throughout the City of Oshkosh and keep a record of speed violators. The records are turned into the Oshkosh Police Department and a letter is sent to the vehicle owner advising them of the speed violation.

The class is limited to 16 persons and training is on a first come, first serve basis. A waiting list will be completed if there are more than 16 people wishing to attend.

All Speed Watch volunteers are required to participate for 8 hours a year.
