Subject: Weapons Charges

MEDIA RELEASE

Oshkosh Police Officers have arrested a 37 year old male from Oshkosh and an 18 year old female from Oshkosh for Recklessly Endangering Safety in two separate incidents.

In the arrest of the 37 year old male, Oshkosh Officers were called to the 600 block of N. Main Street at 1:42 a.m. on January 14, 2012 for a man threatening another man with a gun. The man with the gun left the scene in a vehicle, but an Oshkosh Officer found the vehicle at W. Murdock Ave and Vinland Rd. Officers performed a high risk traffic stop and found the gun in the center console of the vehicle. The gun was a .380 Ruger and was loaded. The man was arrested for Felony 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety-Firearm and transported to the Winnebago County Jail. The victim is a 24 year old male from Oshkosh who bumped into the 37 year old male's vehicle as he was walking down the sidewalk and was then threatened by the 37 year old male with the gun. The victim was uninjured in this incident.

In the arrest of the 18 year old female, Oshkosh Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 700 block of Powers St. on January 13, 2012 for a female threatening a 17 year old male from Oshkosh with a knife. Through their investigation, Oshkosh Officers arrested the 18 year old female for Felony 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety-Knife or Cutting Instrument for threatening to stab the 17 year old male with the knife. The 17 year old male was also arrested Disorderly Conduct after he attempted to punch a third party at the residence. No one was injured in this incident and the 18 year old female and 17 year old male were transported to the Winnebago County Jail.
