### MEDIA RELEASE

The Oshkosh Police Department is no longer investigating the male who was at a residence in the 100 block of W. 19<sup>th</sup> Ave. as being an alleged appraiser that was reported on Thursday, February 24, 2012. The information received from the Oshkosh Branch Anchor Bank was incorrect.

The Oshkosh Branch Anchor Bank advised the Oshkosh Police Department that the male subject attempting to complete an appraisal at the residence on February 23, 2012 was not there employee and was not sent there by them.

On Friday, February 24, 2012, at 1:00 pm, the Madison Branch Anchor Bank alerted the Oshkosh Police Department that the male in question was an appraiser from there branch and had been sent to the residence to complete an appraisal.
