## MEDIA RELEASE

The Oshkosh Police Department is asking for citizen's help in identifying the driver or owner of a hit and run vehicle that struck a 15 year-old male from Oshkosh attempting to cross the 100 block of Josslyn St. on Tuesday, May 22, 2012 at about 3:11 p.m.

The hit and run vehicle that was involved in the crash was north on Josslyn St. and was described as a black GMC SUV with a male white driver with gray hair 50-60 years old with a male white passenger about 50-60 years old with gray hair wearing sunglasses. The vehicle left north on Josslyn St.

The 15 year-old male was not seriously injured in the crash and sustained scrapes and an injured shoulder.
