Subject: Citizen Alert -Subject Trespassing

MEDIA RELEASE

The Oshkosh Police Department is alerting citizens in regards to an individual who has been walking into residences in Oshkosh without permission from the homeowners. This same individual entered a female victim's vehicle in a business parking lot, inappropriately touched the female and stole the female's wallet.

The 46 year-old male from Oshkosh who is a male black, 6'02", 190 lbs, bald with brown eyes was arrested on June 14, 2012 for three incidents that occurred on June 7, 2012. The arrest was for two counts of trespassing, one count of theft, one count of disorderly conduct and one count of possession of stolen property. A 53 year-old female who was driving the vehicle had two counts of Party to the Crime of Trespassing referred against her to the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office on June 7, 2012.

The 46 year-old male was involved in an attempted theft outside a tavern at N. Main St. and Irving Avenue on June 12, 2012. The female in that case did not want to press charges.

On June 14, 2012, at 1:18 pm, a vehicle listing back to the 53 year-old female was observed in the 1300 block of Otter Ave. where a male black was attempting to make contact at residences in the area. The 46 year-old male was taken into custody for the June 7, 2012 incidents and transported to the Winnebago County Jail.

The vehicle involved in all of these incidents has WI plate 111-TLN and lists to a silver 1990 Dodge Caravan.

In the June 7, 2012 incidents, the 46 year-old male had entered two homes on the west side of Oshkosh without the owner's permission. The male pretended to be a delivery person in the first incident at about 1:43 pm and in the second incident a short time later, entered another home while the owner was in the back yard. The male was then driven by the 53 year-old female to a west side super store where he entered the passenger side of a vehicle that was occupied by a female and began making inappropriate remarks, touching the female without her permission, and proceeded to steal the female's wallet.

The 46 year-old male has an extensive criminal record and has been arrested before for battery, domestic abuse battery, sexual assault of a child, retail theft and is a registered sex offender with the State of Wisconsin.

Oshkosh Police are alerting citizens not to allow anyone into their homes or vehicles without their permission and if someone attempts to enter their home or vehicle without their permission, they should call 911. Oshkosh Police are reminding citizen's that if they are outside and at home working or playing in the yard that they should lock all their doors.
