Subject: Media Release Strong Armed Robbery Arrests

Oshkosh Police Department Detectives have arrested a 46 year-old male and a 33 yearold male, both from Oshkosh, after a strong armed robbery was reported on Sunday, July 1, 2012 at 4:20 a.m. in the 100 block of E. Irving Avenue.

The victim, a 55 year-old male from Oshkosh, had invited the two men along with two women to his apartment after bar time. The two men and two women left the victims apartment, but the two men returned and when invited back inside, the 46 year-old male punched the victim. The 46 year-old male along with the 33 year-old male took an undisclosed amount of money, a cell phone and the victim's car keys. The two men ran from the apartment. The victim ran outside after the men and discovered his vehicle was missing. The man had minor injuries and did not require medical attention.

Oshkosh Police Officers and Detectives determined through their investigation the 46 year-old male and the 33 year-old male had committed the strong armed robbery and were arrested on Monday, July 2, 2012 at different locations in Oshkosh. The 46 year-old male was arrested for party to a crime-strong armed robbery and operating a motor vehicle without owner's consent. The 46 year-old has a criminal history of disorderly conduct. The 33 year-old male was arrested for party to a crime-strong armed robbery and has a criminal history of disorderly conduct and bail jumping.

Both males were transported to the Winnebago County Jail. The vehicle was recovered in a parking lot in the 800 block of Merritt Avenue on July 1, 2012.
