Subject: Hit and Run of Bicyclist-Update

MEDIA RELEASE

The Oshkosh Police Department is requesting citizen's help for information in identifying the driver and vehicle involved in a hit and run crash that occurred on Tuesday, July 25, 2012 at about 1:41 a.m. in the 3400 block of Fond du Lac Road.

The vehicle involved in the hit and run is a 2003-2006 Ford Expedition Model. This information was gathered from evidence left at the scene of the hit and run crash. A photo of the model of the vehicle is attached to this media release. The color is unknown.

A 33 year-old male from Oshkosh was riding his bicycle home after work northbound on Fond du Lac Road when a vehicle driving south on Fond du Lac Road, possibly a SUV or pick-up truck, struck the bicyclist head-on in the southbound lane. The male was thrown from his bicycle and sustained a broken left ankle and many scrapes from landing on the ground. The 33 year-old male was transported to Mercy Medical Center for his injuries.

The hit and run vehicle left the scene southbound on Fond du Lac Road without stopping.
