Subject: Domestic Disturbance

## MEDIA RELEASE

Oshkosh Police Department Officer's investigated a domestic disturbance on Monday, October 1, 2012 at about 4:19pm that occurred inside a parked motor vehicle in the 600 block of Leeward Ct. in Oshkosh involving a 19 yearold male from Fond du Lac, WI who was later apprehended by Menomonee Falls Police.

During their investigation, Oshkosh Police Department Officer's learned that the 19 year old male from Fond du Lac, WI had punched the 20 year old female victim several times before driving away in the victim's vehicle. The female victim was able to exit the vehicle with the assistance of other citizens in the area. The female victim was not seriously injured in the disturbance.

Oshkosh Police Officer's also investigated a hit and run of a parked vehicle at N. Main St. and Algoma Blvd. involving the vehicle that was taken from the victim at about 4:29 pm on October 1, 2012. No injuries were reported in the hit and run crash.

Oshkosh Police Officer's contacted the Fond du Lac Police Department and WI State Patrol advising that the 19 year- old male may be coming into their jurisdiction and to be on the lookout for the vehicle. Oshkosh Officer's later learned that the 19 year old male had taken three children from a Fond du Lac residence and later that the 19 year-old male was in custody in Menomonee Falls and that the three children were at Children's Hospital in Milwaukee.

The 19 year-old male has been referred in on charges of Domestic Disorderly Conduct, Domestic Battery and Operating a Motor Vehicle without Owner's Consent to the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office. Citations are also pending on the 19 year-old male for the hit and run crash.
