Subject: Counterfeit Money Thrown On Oshkosh Streets

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating a call of someone throwing thousands of dollars of counterfeit \$20 and \$100 bills onto streets for several blocks near the area of Jackson St. and W. Murdock Avenue last night at about 7:45 pm.

Two citizens picked up some of the bills and brought them to the Oshkosh Police Department. The two citizens reported that there were several other citizens that had stopped to pick up the bills in the area.

The Oshkosh Police Department is asking citizens that may have picked up these bills to bring them to the Oshkosh Police Department. Businesses are encouraged to check currency that they may take in today and if they have a counterfeit bill that has been passed, they should contact the Oshkosh Police Department.

It is unknown at this time who had thrown the bills onto the street. The Oshkosh Police Department continues to investigate this incident. Further information may be passed along when it becomes available.
