Subject: Train vs. Pedestrian Crash Update

The Oshkosh Police Department continues its investigation into a train vs. pedestrian crash that occurred today, June 24, 2013 at about 1:45 pm near E. Custer Ave and Broad St.

The male subject that was deceased upon the arrival of the Oshkosh Police Department was 52 years old and from Oshkosh. It is still unknown why the male subject was on the train tracks. The name of the male is being withheld pending notification of the family has been made.

The train crossings at E. New York Ave, E. Nevada Ave. and E. Murdock Ave were closed until about 3:20 pm during the investigation. Broad St. opened at about 4:10 pm.

The Canadian National train had 2 engines and 91 cars and was en route to the North Fond du Lac switching location.
