Subject: Train vs. Pedestrian Update

The Oshkosh Police Department, in conjunction with the Winnebago County Coroner's Office, has concluded its investigation of a train vs. pedestrian crash that occurred on June 24, 2013 at about 1:45 pm near E. Custer Ave and Broad St.

Witness statements showed the 52 year-old man intentionally walked onto the train tracks, turned toward the train and was struck by the train. The male subject was deceased upon the arrival of the Oshkosh Police Department.

With respect to the family, no other information will be released at this time.
