The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating a sexual assault that occurred in the 200 Block of N. Washburn St, Oshkosh, WI. The assault occurred when the victim stopped in an empty parking lot to fix a flat tire on her car. The suspect stopped to offer assistance with the flat tire and then assaulted the woman.

On Tuesday, June 25, 2013 at around 10:00 AM a woman was driving on N. Washburn St in Oshkosh when one of her vehicle tires went flat. She stopped in a parking lot in the 200 Block of N. Washburn St and started to remove the tire. As she was doing this a man stopped by and asked if she needed any help. At that point the man attacked her. She was able to strike at the man and he eventually left in his car. The suspect was last seen heading north on N. Washburn St., according to the victim and a witness who was in the area.

The male is described as a white male 25-30 years old, 5foot 09inches, about 230lbs, with a bigger belly, clean shaven, and longer blonde hair. He was wearing glasses, a green colored Green Bay Packer jersey, blue jeans, and white athletic shoes. His vehicle is described as a newer white four door similar to a Chevrolet Impala or Pontiac G6. It was last seen heading north on N. Washburn St. from the area of Witzel Av toward Hwy 21.
