Subject:	Oshkosh Police Respond to Two Separate Weapons Calls – Two Arrested

The Oshkosh Police Department arrested two individual males after two separate and unrelated weapons calls were reported.

The first call was on Thursday, April 3, 2014 at about 8:48 pm, a 34 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested after a Domestic Incident in the 200 block of E. Melvin Ave. where Oshkosh Police located a 9MM handgun on the male.

The male had returned home and was involved in a verbal altercation with the 33 year-old female victim. As officers were arriving at the scene of the incident, the officers were informed that the 34 year-old male may have a weapon on his person. The male did not listen to officers commands and officers directed the male to the ground. The 9MM handgun was located by officer's on the male.

The male was arrested for Domestic Disorderly Conduct, Disorderly Conduct, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Recklessly Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon and the No Bond Statute was added. The male was transported to the Winnebago County Jail. The victim and the four children present were not injured in the incident.

The second incident occurred on Sunday, April 6, 2014 at about 7:00 pm in the 800 block of Central St. after a Domestic Incident occurred involving a Compound Bow and the arrest of a 31 year-old male from Oshkosh.

Oshkosh Police responded a set up a perimeter around the residence on Central St. After a short time, it was determined the 31 year-old male suspect was not at home. He was located in the 600 block of N. Main St. at a tavern and arrested for Domestic Disorderly Conduct and Recklessly Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon. He was taken to the Winnebago County Jail.

The victim and two children at the scene were not injured.
