The Oshkosh Police Department is releasing the following information found on the opposite side of this page pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offenders release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his/her previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the <u>potential</u> to offend.

This sex offender <u>has served</u> the sentence imposed on him/her by the courts and has advised officials that he/she will be living in the location on the opposite side of this page. <u>THIS PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME</u>. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTEDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until the passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcements ability to do community notifications. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since the sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

The offender was convicted in 2000 of First Degree Sexual Assault of a Child for Sexually Assaulting a minor female known to him.

Special conditions of supervision:

- (1) Comply with standard sex offender rules, including but not limited to: no unsupervised contact with minors; no taverns/bars/liquor stores; no contact with victims; not to consume alcohol or drugs.
- (2) Face to face contact with Law Enforcement required; Lifetime Registrant of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registration Program.
- (3) Comply with GPS monitoring upon release. Length of GPS monitoring will be subject to review based on supervision adjustment.

Mr. Wastel is being released from prison on April 22, 2014 and will be residing at 2521 Harrison St. in Oshkosh. He is on active supervision with the Department of Corrections until 4/20/30. For more information check www.widocoffenders.org

As of the date of this bulletin there are 23,107 registered sex offenders in Wisconsin. Of those, 5,793 are in prison. 5,460 are on active probation, parole or extended supervision. 11,854 are terminated from supervision. There are 441 registered sex offenders reporting residence in Winnebago County.
