Subject: Death Investigation

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating the suspected heroin overdose death of a 22 year-old female from Oshkosh. A 22 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested on a Probation Hold during the investigation.

The Oshkosh Police Department was called to a residence in the 1700 block of Glenwood Drive on Friday, May 30, 2014 at about 11:20 pm when the mother was unable to contact the 22 year-old female inside the residence. Oshkosh Police entered the bedroom of the 22 year-old female and found her deceased.

The 22 year-old male was arrested at about 9:30 pm on May 31, 2014 in the 700 block of Prospect Ave and transported to the Winnebago County Jail on a Probation Hold.

No charges have been filed in the death of the 22 year-old female and the Oshkosh Police Department continues the investigation.
