Subject: Vehicle vs. Pedestrian Crash Update

The Oshkosh Police Department, in conjunction with the Wisconsin State Patrol, is continuing the investigation into a crash that occurred in the 3100 block of South Washburn St. on June 24, 2014 at about 10:05 PM.

The 23 year-old male from Waushara County who was airlifted by Flight for Life to Theda Clark Hospital in Neenah for his injuries, was later transported to UW-Madison Hospital in critical condition. At this time, we do not have an update as to his condition.

The two other pedestrians, a 20 year-old Winnebago County female and a 22 year-old Marquette County male who were involved in the crash, were treated and released at area hospitals.

The 17 year-old male driver, who was the lone occupant of the vehicle, was cooperative with the investigation and submitted to a blood test. Alcohol is not suspected to be a factor in the crash.

Further information may be released as it becomes available.

If you are driving or walking in the area of Country USA, please be observant to pedestrians and vehicles, respectively, that may be in the area. The speed limit on S. Washburn St. from STH 44 to STH 26 was previously changed for this week and is posted 25 mph. Pedestrians should use the gravel shoulder on the west side of the road and stay off the paved roadway.
