Subject:	Oshkosh Man Arrested for First Degree Reckless Homicide Heroin Death

The Oshkosh Police Department has forwarded an arrest referral to the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office for one count of First Degree Reckless Homicide against Dexter L. Charles, a 23 year-old male from Oshkosh stemming from the death of a 22 year-old female from Oshkosh that occurred on Friday, May 30, 2014.

Charles was arrested for a probation hold on May 31, 2014 during the investigation.

During the investigation by Oshkosh Police, it was discovered that Charles had sold the heroin to the 22 year-old female in Oshkosh on May 30, 2014. At about 11:20 PM, Oshkosh Police responded to a residence in the 1700 block of Glenwood Drive where the 22 year-old female was found deceased. Autopsy results show the 22 year-old female died from acute heroin intoxication.

Charles is currently in the Winnebago County Jail.
