Subject: Oshkosh Police Arrest Two for Heroin Incident

The Oshkosh Police Department arrested a 25 year-old male from Omro for Delivery of Heroin, Possession of Heroin, Recklessly Endangering Safety and a Probation Warrant after a 24 year-old male overdosed on heroin while at work in the 2600 block of Oregon St. on Thursday, September 11, 2014 at about 8:15AM.

The 24 year-old male was revived after NARCAN was administered by the Oshkosh Fire Department. The 24 year-old male was taken to the hospital by Oshkosh Fire and was subsequently arrested after being medically cleared for possession of heroin, marijuana and for possession of drug paraphernalia.

Both males were transported to the Winnebago County Jail.
