Subject: Tree Trimming Employee Scam/Burglary

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating another tree trimming employee scam/burglary.

This occurred on Wednesday, October 15, 2014 at about 3:15 PM in the 1800 block of Oregon St.

Two male subjects who were wearing safety vests contacted the home owner. The first male suspect contacted the home owner and said that a tree needed to be cut in the backyard. The first suspect stated he needed \$100 for the tree cutting, but told the home owner that he could not accept a \$100 bill. The first suspect told the home owner to meet his supervisor outside in the back yard.

The home owner went to the back yard and met with a second suspect. The first suspect stayed inside the residence and took an undisclosed amount of money from the home.

Both suspects left in a small, white, single cab pick-up truck. The only description was of the first suspect possibly being Hispanic and 5'8" - 5'10" in height.

The Oshkosh Police Department believes this incident is related to other employee scams/burglaries occurring in Oshkosh.
