Subject: Burglaries

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating numerous forced entry burglaries from businesses in Oshkosh. Since November 1, 2014, Oshkosh Police has taken 27 burglary complaints. These burglaries have been reported mainly along the frontage road on Koeller St and Washburn St. and in the downtown Oshkosh area.

Taken in some of these incidents were cash. Some of the other businesses were broken into, but nothing was taken.

Oshkosh Police are asking businesses throughout the area to remove any and all cash/credit receipts from their businesses on a nightly basis. Leave interior and exterior lights on and remove obstructions from exterior windows.

Businesses are asked if they have a security video, please make sure that it is in operation and that employees know how to operate the equipment. We also ask businesses to contact their alarm companies and advise them to call the Winnebago County Dispatch Center at (920) 424-0061 at the time an active alarm is detected.

Please report any and all suspicious incidents or persons. Your call is important and may prevent or solve a crime.

Oshkosh Police continue the investigation into all of these incidents.
