

## City of Oshkosh Police Department sex offender information bulletin authorized by: chief scott greuel JANUARY 26, 2015 BULLETIN #: 2015-02

The Oshkosh Police Department is releasing the following information found on the opposite side of this page pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 and 301.46 (Act 440), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offenders release when, at the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety and protection.

The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense that requires registration with the local law enforcement agencies. Further, his/her previous criminal history places the offender in a classification level which reflects the <u>potential</u> to offend.

This sex offender <u>has served</u> the sentence imposed on him/her by the courts and has advised officials that he/she will be living in the location on the opposite side of this page. <u>THIS</u> <u>PERSON IS NOT WANTED BY THE POLICE AT THIS TIME</u>. THIS NOTIFICATION IS NOT INTEDED TO INCREASE FEAR; RATHER, IT IS OUR BELIEF THAT AN INFORMED PUBLIC IS A SAFER PUBLIC.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities but it was not until the passage of Act 440 (which mandates sex offender registration) that law enforcement even knew where they were living. In many cases, law enforcement is now able to share that information with you. Citizen abuse of this information to threaten, intimidate or harass registered sex offenders will not be tolerated. Further, such abuse could potentially end law enforcements ability to do community notifications. We believe the only person who wins if community notification ends is the sex offender, since the sex offenders derive their power through secrecy.

The Oshkosh Police Department is available to help you set up a Neighborhood Watch and to provide you with useful information on personal safety. ## RONALD K. SPIERING ALIASES: BEAR; FARMER SPIERING 145A HIGH AVENUE #5 DOB: 07/31/1959 55 YEARS OLD 5'09" TALL 224 LBS DARK BROWN (BALDING) HAIR HAZEL EYES SCARS: ABDOMEN TATTOOS: NONE NOTED

The offender was convicted in 2005 for 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of an adult female acquaintance by force. The court sentenced him to 9 yrs prison followed by 5 yrs extended supervision. The offender has two previous convictions of sexual assault. In 1985, the offender was convicted of 1st Degree Sexual Assault after assaulting a 3 year-old non-relative female who was known to him, and was sentenced by the court to a 4 yr prison term and a consecutive 1 yr jail term. In 1995, the offender was convicted of 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault of a Child after drugging a 15 year-old non-relative female who was known to him and sexually assaulting her. He was sentenced by the court to a 10 yr prison term.

## SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISION:

(1) Comply with standard sex offender rules, including but not limited to: no unsupervised contact with minors; no taverns/bars/liquor stores; no contact with victims; not to consume alcohol or drugs.
(2) Face to face contact with Law Enforcement required; Lifetime Registrant of the Wisconsin Sex

Offender Registration Program.

(3) Comply with Lifetime GPS monitoring.

As of 1/20/15 there are 23,509 registered sex offenders in Wisconsin. Of those, 5,818 are in prison. 5,596 are on active probation, parole or extended supervision. 12095 are terminated from supervision. There are 458 registered sex offenders reporting residence in Winnebago County.
