Subject: Theft – False Representation Arrests

MEDIA RELEASE

The Oshkosh Police Department arrested a 37 year-old male from Winneconne, WI on two separate occasions in the last four months for theft – false representation in excess of \$10,000 by using his business to commit the thefts totaling in excess of \$100,000 on these two occasions.

Craig Stueck, was arrested in November 2014 and charged by the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office for theft-false representation in excess of \$10,000 and one count of forgery. Stueck was arrested once again on February 19, 2015 for theft-false representation in excess of \$10,000 and for bail jumping, which is related to his first arrest. He has since been charged by the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office.

Stueck had been sub-contracting concrete work in the Oshkosh area to other construction companies. Stueck failed to pay for the services of the companies that he had sub-contracted after he was paid by the property owners.
