Disturbance

Disorderly/Resisting

A 21 year-old female from Oshkosh was taken into custody for disorderly conduct after neighbors reported someone running through yards and street near Ida Ave and Central St. screaming. Officers were sent to check on the welfare of the female and the female was found to be highly intoxicated. As officers attempted to help the female, the female began running. Officers were able to stop the female, but the female began kicking at officers. She was placed in handcuffs and placed in a squad car where she attempted to kick the windows out. She was transported to Mercy Medical Center for observation and medical clearance. While at the hospital, she began resisting medical staff's efforts to assist her. She was eventually cleared medically and taken to the Winnebago County Jail.

OWI

A 22 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for 1st offense OWI after a traffic stop was initiated on his vehicle at S. Main St. and W. 11th Ave for an equipment violation. The 22 year-old male was cited for the OWI; having a prohibited BAC while operating; operating while suspended; possession of marijuana; and drug paraphernalia.
