Monday-September 21, 2015

A 16 year-old male from Oshkosh had a referral arrest sent to Juvenile Intake for resisting an officer after he was found walking naked in the area of Jackson St. and W. Murdock Ave. He was eventually found at Kentucky St. at W. Nevada Ave. The juvenile attempted to exit a police car through a window and was disruptive with officers and hospital staff while being examined after he was transported by ambulance to the hospital. The male was transported to FDL secure detention on a 72 hour-hold.
