Thursday-November 19, 2015

Domestic – 800 block of Oak St.

A 47 year-old female from Oshkosh was arrested for domestic endangering safety by reckless use of a weapon after she was involved in a domestic disturbance in the 800 block of Oak St. She was taken to jail.

OWI Drugged Driving Crash – Dawes St. at High Ave.

A 19 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for 1st offense OWI drugged driving after his vehicle was east on High Avenue, left the roadway and struck a power pole, cutting it off at the base. The vehicle spun around and ended on Dawes St. The 19 year-old had minor injuries from the crash. The 19 year-old was found to have been smoking marijuana prior to the crash. He was released to a responsible adult.

Disturbance – 1300 block of Jefferson St.

A 30 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for felon in possession of a firearm after a report of a possible domestic disturbance was given to police in the 1300 block of Jefferson St. A semi-automatic handgun was located and the male was taken to jail.

Domestic – 700 block of Starboard Ct. West

A 19 year-old female was arrested for domestic disorderly conduct in the 700 block of Starboard Ct. West after she was involved in a domestic disturbance. She was taken to jail.

Disturbance – 800 block of W. 10th Ave.

A 20 year-old male from Oshkosh was cited for underage drinking and possession of a false ID on him when he barged into a home in the 800 block of W. 10th Ave. He was released to a responsible adult.

Saturday, November 21, 2015

Damage – 1700 Jackson St.

A report of damage done to a residence in the 1700 block of Jackson St. The investigation continues.

Animal – 3700 Glenshire Ln.

An anonymous tip was reported to police of a residence having an alligator, snakes and other animals in the 3700 block of Glenshire Ln. Officers investigated and found 29 animals inside the residence, including a 2 ½ foot alligator, eight snakes, spiders and other animals. The investigation continues on this incident and placement for the animals will be taking place.

Loud Party/Disturbance – 500 block of Marion Rd.

A loud party was reported in the 500 block Marion Rd. Officers arrived and the occupants of the apartment would not answer the door, but continued to be loud. A fight broke out inside the apartment which prompted the officers to enter.

A 20 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for disorderly conduct, resisting an officer, and possession of a prescription medicine w/out a prescription. Another 20 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for disorderly conduct and resisting an officer. A 19 year-old male from Omro, WI was arrested for bail jumping. These males were taken to jail.

A total of 14 ordinance citations were written for underage drinking, disturbing the peace and permitting underage consumption on premises to 8 individuals.

A representative of the apartment complex was notified of the disturbance.

OWI 2nd Offense/Crash – W. 18th Ave at Simpson St.
