Damage to Property – Follow-Up – 2100 block of S. Oakwood Rd.

A 42 year-old male from Oshkosh was cited for illegal discharge of a firearm in the city and was referred to the district attorney's office for damage to property after an investigation that began on November 27, 2015 found he used a shotgun to shoot at a coyote in the 2100 block of S. Oakwood Rd., but instead damaged two windows at a business. Investigation closed.

Disturbance – 2200 block of Westowne Ave.

A 25 year-old male from Ripon, WI was arrested on a warrant, disorderly conduct and resisting arrest after he was involved in a disturbance in the 2200 block of Westowne Ave. The male began walking away from officers after he was told to stop. He was taken to jail.
