Monday-December 21, 2015

Community Policing – Washington Elementary School

Welfare Check – Bail Jumping – 300 block of S. Washburn St.

A 38 year-old female from Oshkosh, who had been arrested over the past weekend for 'huffing' spray paint, was arrested again after a welfare check was reported in the 300 block of S. Washburn St. The 38 year-old female was located inside a restroom 'huffing' a can of spray paint. She was arrested and taken to jail for abusing hazardous substances and bail jumping.

Welfare Check – 2200 block of W. Waukau Ave.

The Oshkosh Police Department took a 30 year-old male from Oshkosh into custody for a mental evaluation after an initial call for a welfare check was reported to police. Oshkosh Police responded to the 2200 block of W. Waukau Ave. at about 12:17 pm. When officers arrived, they attempted to make contact with the 30 year-old male, who was allegedly inside a storage unit. Police did not find the subject inside.

The male was eventually located in the 1300 block of Maricopa Dr. by police. The male pulled a knife as officers were giving directions to stop. A less lethal projectile munitions launcher was

used to stop the male. He was taken into custody in the 1200 block of Washburn St. at about 1:57 p.m.

The male had self-inflicted cuts to his wrist and injuries from the rubber tipped projectiles used to stop him. He was transported to a local hospital where he is being evaluated for his injuries. The male will have charges forthcoming against him; and he was also had a warrant out for his arrest.

Theft – 300 block of S. Washburn St.

A 24 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for six counts of uttering, one count of theft and a probation hold after he forged six checks at a business in October 2015 on various dates. The 24 year-old male was located at his residence in the 900 block of N. Westfield St. He was taken to jail.
