Subject: Strong Armed Robbery/ Armed Burglary – Arrests Made

The Oshkosh Police Department is continuing their investigation into an isolated armed robbery/burglary which occurred at about midnight on Monday, February 15, 2016 to a residence in the 1000 block of Jefferson St.

Five males, all from Oshkosh, were subsequently arrested on Monday, February 15, 2016.

Oshkosh Police responded to the residence after the robbery was reported where five males entered the residence, struck the victim, took undisclosed items and left the scene. Four of the males were located and arrested shortly after the incident.

Oshkosh Police were able to locate a 21 year-old male at Broad St. and Washington Ave. He was arrested for a probation hold.

A 19 year-old male was arrested for party to a crime of robbery; party to a crime of burglary; and bail jumping after he was located walking at Washington Ave. and Broad St.

A 17 year-old male and 16 year-old male were located walking at Marquette Ave. and Kaitlyn Ct. The 17 year-old male was arrested for armed robbery and armed burglary; and the 16 year-old male was arrested for armed robbery, armed burglary and a warrant.

The 21, 19, and 17 year old males were taken to jail. The 16 year-old male was transported to Fond du Lac County Secure Detention.

An 18 year-old male was arrested at about 12:30 PM in the 200 block of Waugoo Ave. for party to a crime of robbery; party to a crime of burglary and two counts of bail jumping. He was taken to jail.
