Reckless Endangering Safety with a Knife – 600 block of W. 10th Ave.

A 45 year-old male from Oshkosh was arrested for felony reckless endangering safety with a knife after he threatened another person with a knife in the 600 block of W. 10th Ave. He was arrested without further incident and taken to jail. No one was injured in the incident.
