Subject: **\*\*\*UPDATE\*\*\*** Pedestrian Struck by Train-Victim's Name  
Released

This Oshkosh Police Department, in conjunction with the Winnebago County Coroner's Office, is releasing the name of the Oshkosh man who was struck by a train on March 11, 2016.

Sawyer J. Zeinert, 20 years-old, was killed after he was struck by the train.

The information gathered so far by investigators indicates Sawyer was riding his bicycle north on the east sidewalk along Fond du Lac Rd. around 10:30 PM on March 11, 2016. The bicycle struck the edge of a concrete wall of a small bridge on STH 45/S. Main St. The collision between the bicycle and the bridge caused Sawyer to be ejected from the bicycle. It is believed Sawyer was injured during the collision between the bicycle and the bridge. This may have caused Sawyer to become disoriented. The investigation continues.

The Oshkosh Police Department is looking to speak with anyone who may have seen a person that appeared disoriented in the area of Fond du Lac Rd and W 24<sup>th</sup> Av in Oshkosh between 10:30PM and Midnight on March 11, 2016.
