Subject: Oshkosh Police Request Citizens Help in Identifying Battery  
Suspect

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating a substantial battery that occurred at the Jockey Club, 24 E. Gruenwald Ave. on Friday, April 8, 2016 at about 9:30 PM that began inside the tavern and continued outside.

The suspect substantially battered the victim, a 20 year-old male from Oshkosh. The victim had substantial facial injuries due to the incident and was taken by ambulance to a local hospital for his injuries.

The suspect is described as a tall white male wearing a plaid jacket. He had a partially amputated middle finger on his left hand. The suspect was last seen running toward N. Main St. from the tavern after the incident.
