Subject: Armed Robbery 21 Shell Gas Station

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating an armed robbery that occurred on Monday, November 7, 2016 at about 11:30pm at the 21 Shell Gas Station, 2250 Westowne Avenue in Oshkosh.

An employee stated that the male suspect came into the gas station and said he had a gun, although a gun was never displayed. The suspect told the employee to give him all the cash and the suspect left west through the parking lot after the robbery. The Oshkosh Police Department and the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office searched the area, but did not locate the suspect.

The suspect is described as a black male, 5'09"-6'00", about 170 lbs. and was wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt.

The suspect left with an undisclosed amount of cash.
