Subject: New Computerized Handheld Parking Ticket Devices

On Tuesday, May 2nd, 2017 the Oshkosh Police Department will begin using new computerized handheld ticket writers to enforce parking ordinances throughout the City. The seven devices will replace a small number of older devices and will be used to issue almost all parking tickets citywide. As a result, citizens will see fewer of the green, hand-written parking tickets and more of the blue & white computer generated tickets.

This is a good time to remind citizens that parking is prohibited on City streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 5:00 am unless the owner of the vehicle was granted advance permission or has purchased a city parking permit from the Oshkosh Police Department. With permission or a valid permit, vehicles can legally park on the odd or even side of the street depending on the date.
