Subject: Drug Arrests

On Wednesday, May 3, 2017, the Oshkosh Police Department Vice and Narcotic Unit, with assistance from the LWAM Drug Unit and Winnebago County Sheriff's Office, executed a search warrant in the 600 block of Boyd St. in the City of Oshkosh after an investigation and seven people from Oshkosh were arrested.

A 30 year-old male was taken into custody on a Probation Violation; a 55 year-old male was taken into custody on an outstanding warrant and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia; a 56 year-old female was taken into custody for a drug related warrant and for Manufacturing and Delivery of Cocaine; a 31 year-old male was taken into custody for Maintaining a Drug Dwelling and Manufacturing and Delivery of Cocaine; a 48 year old male was taken into custody for Possession of Cocaine as a repeater; a 54 year old female was taken into custody for Party to the Crime of Manufacturing and Delivery of Cocaine and Bail jumping; and a 49 year old female was taken into custody for Maintaining a Drug Dwelling and a Probation Hold.

All of the subjects were taken to the Winnebago County Jail.
