Subject: Motor Vehicle-Pedestrian Hit and Run Injury Crash

MEDIA RELEASE

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating a Hit and Run motor vehicle vs. pedestrian injury crash that occurred on October 21, 2010 at 11:25am at the Kwik Trip 215 W. 20th Avenue. The suspect driver in the photos is described as a male white in his early 20's, medium build, dark hair, wearing a long sleeve gray and white striped shirt, blue jeans, and white tennis shoes. The vehicle is described as an older, black in color, possibly an Oldsmobile, that had no plates on the outside of the vehicle. An employee observed a partial plate inside the vehicle with the numbers 935.

An employee at Kwik Trip recognized the vehicle as being involved in five other gas drive offs and as the employee went to confront the driver, the driver left striking the employee with the vehicle and left the scene travelling south on Oregon Street. The employee sustained injuries that were not life threatening, but was transported to Mercy Hospital for precautionary measures.
