## MEDIA RELEASE

Oshkosh Police Detectives are continuing their investigation into a weapons complaint that occurred at 5:41 pm on Sunday, June 10, 2012 at 1003 Adams St. in Oshkosh, WI.

The 48 year-old man who lived in the home and was involved in the incident was not injured and was taken to Mercy Medical Center in Oshkosh and placed on an emergency committal. When the man is released from the hospital, he will be transported to the Winnebago County Jail for Disorderly Conduct and 1st Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety.

During their investigation, Oshkosh Detectives found that the 48 year-old man had used a shotgun to shoot two shot gun slugs within the home. One slug was located in the home and the other slug exited the home. The neighborhood where the incident occurred was canvassed by Oshkosh Police Detectives and Officers, but neither the slug nor any damage was located. Neighbors were alerted to contact the Oshkosh Police Department if the slug was located or if damage was found to their property.

No one else was in the home at the time of the incident.
