Subject: Crash Vehicle vs. Pedestrians

The Oshkosh Police Department investigated a vehicle vs. pedestrian crash in the 300 block of N. Koeller St. on Monday, December 29, 2014 at about 9:30PM.

Oshkosh Police determined that a 21year-old male and 22 year-old female were pushing a stroller with a one year-old male north on N. Koeller St. in the right lane of traffic when a Chrysler PT Cruiser being driven by a 26 year-old female from Oshkosh made contact with the 21 year-old and the stroller with the one year-old.

The 21 year-old was transported to Theda Clark Hospital in Neenah, WI with non-life threatening injuries to the leg and head. The one year-old was taken to Aurora Hospital with non-life threatening injuries. The 22 year-old female who was walking with the 21 year-old male and one year-old male was not injured.

Alcohol and drugs do not appear to be involved in the crash and the 26 year-old driver was cooperative and did submit to a blood test. Test results will be released once analysis is complete.
