Subject:	Homicide

The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating a homicide that involved multiple people that occurred in the 500 block of Mt. Vernon Street on Friday, April 6, 2018 at approximately 2:17 AM.

An 18 year old male from Oshkosh was pronounced dead at the scene after sustaining multiple stab wounds. A second individual identified as an 18 year old male also from Oshkosh was transported to a local hospital with multiple stab wounds where he is currently in the Intensive Care Unit being treated for his injuries.

Oshkosh Police are looking for a suspect involved with the stabbings who is described as a light skin black male who is approximately 18-20 years of age. The suspect was last seen wearing dark colored pants, no shirt or shoes. The suspect may have sustained a stab wound and he may be in need of medical assistance. Local hospitals have been notified.

Oshkosh Police do not believe the community is in danger as the victims were known to the suspect. At this time no arrests have been made regarding this incident. The Oshkosh Police Department is continuing to work to identify the individuals involved.
