Subject: Update-Homicide Mt Vernon

The Oshkosh Police Department is continuing to investigate a homicide that occurred in the 500 block of Mt. Vernon Street on Friday, April 6, 2018 at approximately 1:31 AM.

The initial information that was received by this department, indicated that there was a marijuana deal that occurred during this homicide. After further investigation, and with corroborating witness statements and evidence, the investigation revealed that this was a retaliatory event in regards to a prior drug incident between the involved parties.

The Winnebago District Attorney's Office has charged Charles M. Martin, a 17 year old male from Oshkosh, with the following charges: First Degree Intentional Homicide, Attempt First Degree Intentional Homicide, and Burglary to a Dwelling.

An autopsy was performed on the victim, Noah A. Williams, an 18 year old male from Oshkosh, on 04/09/2018. The Winnebago County Coroner Barry Busby has stated that the cause of death was from multiple stab wounds.
