UPDATE:

Roemance L Toney, who had been reported as an escapee from the Drug Abuse Correctional Center located at 4280 Sherman Rd, has been taken into custody.

The Oshkosh Police Department was notified on 11/18/2018 that Toney was located in the City of Appleton and was arrested by the Appleton Police Department on a warrant issued by the Department of Corrections.

The arrest was made without incident. The Oshkosh Police Department will be referring Toney to the Winnebago County District Attorney's Office for the crime of Escape.

On 11/17/2018, at approximately 2:34 PM, the Oshkosh Police Department was notified that a male had escaped from the Drug Abuse Correctional Center located at 4280 Sherman Rd in the City of Oshkosh. DACC is part of the Wisconsin Correctional Center System.

The male has been identified as Roemance L Toney: a black male, DOB 08/08/1992. He is 5'9 145 pounds with Brown hair (dreadlocks) and Brown eyes. Past convictions include: Armed Robbery with Use of Force, Burglary, and Escape. His residence was in the Milwaukee Area.

He was last seen wearing gray sweatpants and sweatshirt with black shoes.

The Oshkosh Police Department is seeking any information about the whereabouts of this male. If anybody has any information regarding this
