Subject: Dog located with broken leg and injuries from a firearm

OSHKOSH, WI (May 7, 2019): The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating an animal complaint in which a dog was found with a broken leg and injuries caused by some type of firearm.

On April 30, 2019 at approximately 5:48 PM, an OPD Community Service Officer responded to the area of Jackson St and Smith Avenue in the City of Oshkosh for a report of a dog that was loose. Upon arrival at that location, it appeared that the dog was limping. The dog was turned over to staff at the Oshkosh Area Humane Society. X rays revealed that the dog's leg was severely fractured and required leg amputation. X rays also revealed that the dog had injuries caused by some type of firearm.

Based on further investigation, it is believed that the dog may have come from the Omro area before being located on Jackson St in Oshkosh.
