**Subject: UPDATE 2: Death Investigation of Two Adults**

**UPDATE 2: On 10/14/2019 the autopsies of these two individuals were completed by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office. In conjunction with the Winnebago County Coroner's Office, we are releasing the names of these two deceased individuals.**

**The adult female is identified as Peggy J Carpenter DOB: 11/14/1972 and the adult male is identified as Paul R Guerrero DOB: 09/16/1964. Initial investigation and witness statements reveal that Guerrero shot Carpenter multiple times and that she died from these gunshot wounds. It appears that Guerrero died from a self-inflicted gunshot wound.**

UPDATE: On 10/10/2019 and into the morning hours of 10/11/2019, the Oshkosh Police Department's SWAT team, Crisis Negotiation Team, the Accident Investigation Team along with the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office and the Oshkosh Fire Department responded to the 200 Block of E Tennessee Avenue to investigate a weapons complaint. The Oshkosh Police Department had received information that gunshots had been heard in that area.

Upon further investigation, a 46 year old female from Oshkosh and a 55 year old male from Appleton were located deceased inside of a residence in the 200 block of E Tennessee. Preliminary investigation indicates that both individuals died from gunshot wounds. We are not looking for any suspects at this time and feel that this was an isolated incident. The 200 Block of E Tennessee is no longer closed to traffic.

OSHKOSH, WI (October 11, 2019): The Oshkosh Police Department is investigating two deaths that occurred in the 200 Block of E Tennessee Avenue in the City of Oshkosh.

On 10/10/2019 at approximately 10:43 PM, officers were dispatched to a weapons complaint in the 200 Block of E Tennessee Avenue. Upon further investigation, an adult male and an adult female were located inside of a residence, both deceased. These two individuals were known to each other and this is an isolated incident. The public is not in any danger. The 200 Block of E Tennessee Avenue will be closed to traffic as we continue the investigation.
