Subject: **UPDATE Hit and Run Traffic Fatality**

UPDATE: A 21 year old male from Oshkosh was taken into custody and placed in the Winnebago County Jail. The Oshkosh Police Department is no longer seeking the public's assistance in locating the striking vehicle or it's driver. New York Avenue is now open to normal traffic.

OSHKOSH, WI (October 05, 2024): The Oshkosh Police Department is currently investigating a hit and run traffic fatality that occurred on New York Avenue and Goss Court in the City of Oshkosh.

At approximately 2:55 AM, Officers were dispatched to the area of New York Avenue and Goss Court. The scene involved a pedestrian lying in the roadway that appeared to have been struck by a vehicle. The striking vehicle left the scene prior to officers arrival and may have traveled westbound over the Congress Avenue Bridge.

The pedestrian was administered lifesaving measures by responding officers and paramedics but was pronounced deceased on scene.

The Oshkosh Police Department's Accident Investigation Team and OPD Detectives responded to the scene and are continuing to investigate this incident. New York Avenue between Algoma Boulevard and Elmwood Street is currently closed. Please avoid this area.

The Oshkosh Police Department is encouraging those that live in the area to check your security cameras for any activity between the hours of 12 AM and 3 AM.
